

CONDITIONS OF PLAY

KEW MEN'S BOWLING CLUB

The Controlling Body and Match Committee are the President, Vice-President and Bowls Co-ordinator of the KEW Men's Bowling Club. Any affiliated member may be appointed by the Controlling Body to act as the Controlling Body for a day of competition. The Controlling Body reserves the right to take any necessary action to bring the tournament to a successful conclusion.

All games will be played under the current laws of the sport of bowls as described in "Crystal Mark 4th Edition" dated April 2023.

Only fully paid members registered with Bowls NSW are eligible to play in these Kew Men's Bowling Club Competitions.

MONDAY MONTHLY - 3 Bowl Pairs (Max 28 Teams)

The tournament is three games of fourteen ends. It is open to mens, ladies and mixed teams. The entry fee is \$50 per team not including lunch. There are no "dead ends" - jack to be re-spotted on the T. There are no roll-ups. Overall and round winners will be decided on wins and draws (3 points win, 1 point draw) ends and, margins (if required), over the 3 games.

Prize Money – Only 1 prize per team. 1st to 3rd are not eligible for round winning games

1st Depends on number of entries (Max \$350)

2nd Depends on number of entries (Max \$250)

3rd Depends on number of entries (Max \$150)

Round Winners x 3 \$50 per team

FRIDAY JACKPOT - 3 Bowl Triples (Max 28 Teams)

The tournament is one game of twenty one ends. It is open to mens, ladies and mixed teams. The entry fee is \$30 per team. There are no "dead ends" - jack to be re-spotted on the T. No roll ups.

Jackpot Draw

Jackpot starts at \$200 rising by \$1 for each player entered each week if not won. Must be won when jackpot reaches \$1000.

An Electronic Spinning Wheel numbered from 1 to 30 will be used to determine a total margin number for winning teams only. To win the jackpot the number drawn must correspond with a teams total margin.

If the winning margin jackpot is not won, then a new spin will determine a \$150 prize for losing teams only, using the score for losing teams. Any draws will share the prizes equally.

If no jackpot is won then winning and losing rink teams will win a prize determined by spinning a range of rink numbers.

SATURDAY CASH POT - 2 Bowl Triples (Max 28 Teams)

The tournament is 2 games of 13 ends. It is open to mens, ladies and mixed teams. The entry fee is \$30 per team. There are no "dead ends" - jack to be re-spotted on the T. There are no roll ups. Winners will be decided on wins, ends and, margins.

Prize Money – The Cash Pot prizes are awarded for

Team with 2 Wins and highest Ends and Margins

Team with 1 Win and 1 Loss and highest Ends and Margins

Team with 2 Losses and highest Ends and Margins
